#### New Paradigm

- Faculty: actors
- Faculty: designers of learning experiences
- Faculty responsible for content, media, assessment
- Faculty work as part of instructional team
- Student role = empty vessel
- Student role = knowledge creator
- Faculty work for one institution
- Faculty work for multiple institutions/independently

#### Old Paradigm

#### New Paradigm

- Semester/trimester/quarter
- Varying lengths of time for learning modules
- Courses part of an accredited institutional curriculum
- Courses independent of institution and independedly accredited
- Set enrollments (e.g., once a year)
- Continuous enrollments (e.g., on demand, any time, any place)
- Institutions act independently
- Institutions act with partners
